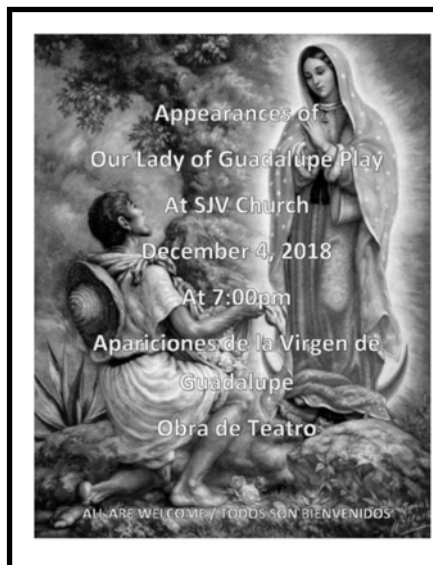

FAITH FORMATION

Family Discussion: Understanding today's feast of Christ the King may be particularly challenging. While most of us do not have direct experience with kings or royalty, we have a sense of who they are. We know that royalty have sovereignty over their kingdoms. We know that those who are subjects to royalty offer them allegiance and honor. To understand how Christ is our king, we extend and magnify what we know to be true of the best of human royalty. Christ's kingship extends to all places, all people, and all times. Christ manifests his kingship through his death on the cross in which he offered salvation to everyone. Those who can see with eyes of faith recognize Jesus to be our heavenly king.

As you gather as a family, recall that this Sunday is the last Sunday in the Church year and on this Sunday we celebrate the feast of Christ the King. Talk together about what it means to be a king or queen. How do those who are subjects behave toward royalty? Invite children to role-play what one does in the presence of royalty. Read today's Gospel, John 18:33b-37. Ask your family to discuss these questions: Does Pilate treat Jesus like royalty? (No.) What does Jesus say about his kingdom? (It is not of this world.) Talk about how your family shows honor and obedience to Christ our King. Pray together the Lord's Prayer and ask God to help your family act in ways that show you recognize and honor Christ as King.

Theme: Jesus is questioned by Pilate about the charge brought against him that he is "King of the Jews."

Summary:

In this passage from Saint John's Gospel, Pilate, an earthly ruler, questions Jesus about whether or not he is a king. Pilate is caught in the direct and narrow understanding of earthly kingship, while Jesus represents a divine kingship, which is one where he acts as a **servant**. Jesus is a leader who is so different from the leaders of today, who are often seen as failures. People yearn for a leader who will care for and **serve** them. Be attentive to the fact that a true **servant** leader attends to the needs of the people rather than to their "wants."

Scripture:

"You are a king, then!" said Pilate. Jesus answered, "You are right in saying I am a king. In fact, for this reason I was born, and for this I came into the world, to testify to the truth. Everyone on the side of truth listens to me." **John 18:37**

During his last days on earth, Jesus was arrested and put on trial.

When asked if he was a king, Jesus answered, "You are right in saying I am a king.

In fact, for this reason I was born, and for this I came into the world."

Yes, Jesus was a king, but he wasn't interested

in running around free and doing things his way.

He was only interested in doing the will of his Father.

TRIGESIMO CUARTO DOMINGO EN TIEMPO ORDINARIO

“SOLEMNIDAD DE CRISTO REY”

Cristo Rey

Llegamos con este domingo al final del año litúrgico. La conclusión es sencilla, y sirve de título para la solemnidad de hoy: Cristo es el Rey. Como los pocos reyes que quedan en nuestro tiempo son casi sólo figuras decorativas, quizás nos cuesta descubrir el poder de esa expresión: el Señor reina, Cristo es el Rey. Tal vez la manera más directa de reconocer el poder evocador que aquí se esconde es tomar la frase de modo complementario, es decir, mirando nuestro ser en cuanto súbditos de ese rey. Aunque son equivalentes, las dos frases "Jesús es mi Señor" y "Yo soy siervo de Cristo" tienen diverso poder en el corazón y en la mente.

Pero no se trata de un asunto personal y devocional solamente, como podría sugerirlo una expresión en primera persona: "Él es mi Señor." Cristo es Rey de todos, no sólo de los que admiten su reinado. El nombre completo de esta fiesta es: Cristo Rey del Universo, o sea, Cristo como rey de todo y de todos.

Una celebración en la Esperanza

Sin embargo, no vemos ahora que Cristo esté reinando en todo y en todos. Las noticias de violencia y de injusticia no sólo desalientan nuestra fe sino que nos pueden hacer dudar de la eficacia última del sacrificio de Cristo. Por todas partes, incluyendo naciones de mayoría cristiana o católica, se traicionan o infringen los principios que hemos recibido del Evangelio: ¿cómo es entonces que decimos que Cristo es Rey? Lo decimos como un ejercicio de fe, porque su Resurrección afecta a todo el universo y no sólo a los seguidores de Cristo, y lo decimos sobre todo como un ejercicio de esperanza. Las lecturas de los últimos días nos han preparado en ese sentido, pues la literatura llamada apocalíptica es siempre una invitación a mirar el conjunto de la Historia humana, y a reconocer en todo ese conjunto el plan de Dios.

"Mi Reino no es de este Mundo"

El evangelio de hoy trae una frase que se ha prestado para numerosas interpretaciones, algunas de ellas francamente erradas. Es importante en este caso revisar el texto original griego. Lo que dice el Señor es que su Reino no es "ek tou kosmou toutou." La clave es la preposición "ek" que suele traducirse por "de." Pero no es cualquier "de," es un "de" que indica procedencia, como cuando alguien dice que es "de Medellín."

La frase de Cristo queda entonces mejor traducida como la encontramos en el Leccionario aprobado para Colombia: "No es el mundo el que me ha hecho rey." Jesús no está diciendo que su Reino no toca las realidades de este mundo sino que no depende de la autorización o de los poderes de este mundo y que en ese sentido goza de la libertad y el poder que sólo Dios puede dar.
